RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROOME COUNTY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND THE TOWN OF VESTAL POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE VILLAGE OF ENDICOTT POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE NEW YORK STATE UNIVERSITY POLICE AT BINGHAMTON UNIVERSITY AND THE SOUTHERN TIER CRIME ANALYSIS CENTER FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SYSTEMS DATA SHARING AND STORAGE

WHEREAS, the Director of Information Technology requests authorization for a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agreement between Broome County Information Technology and the Town of Vestal Police Department, the Village of Endicott Police Department, the City of Binghamton Police Department, the Village of Johnson City Police Department, the New York State University Police at Binghamton University and the Southern Tier Crime Analysis Center for the sharing of law enforcement systems data for a period of five years from the date of execution, and

WHEREAS, said agreement is necessary to define the service expectations for the storage of and access to law enforcement data shared with and by law enforcement systems located on the network operated by Broome County such as New World Public Safety, TRACS and AutoMon, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agreement between Broome County Information Technology and the Town of Vestal Police Department, the Village of Endicott Police Department, the City of Binghamton Police Department, the Village of Johnson City Police Department, the New York State University Police at Binghamton University and the Southern Tier Crime Analysis Center for the sharing of law enforcement systems data for a period of five years from the date of execution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in consideration of said services, the Contractors shall pay the County at the rate of \$70 per hour for any support outside of the normal maintenance as described in the agreement, for the term of the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
